Picking up the highway to leafy Edgbaston we link up with the Tolkien trail and the world famous Cardinal Newman Oratory.

Finally entering the city through the East Side Extravaganza we get the full panoramic view of St Martin's Parish Church and the state of the art Bullring shopping complex with the iconic building of Selfridges.

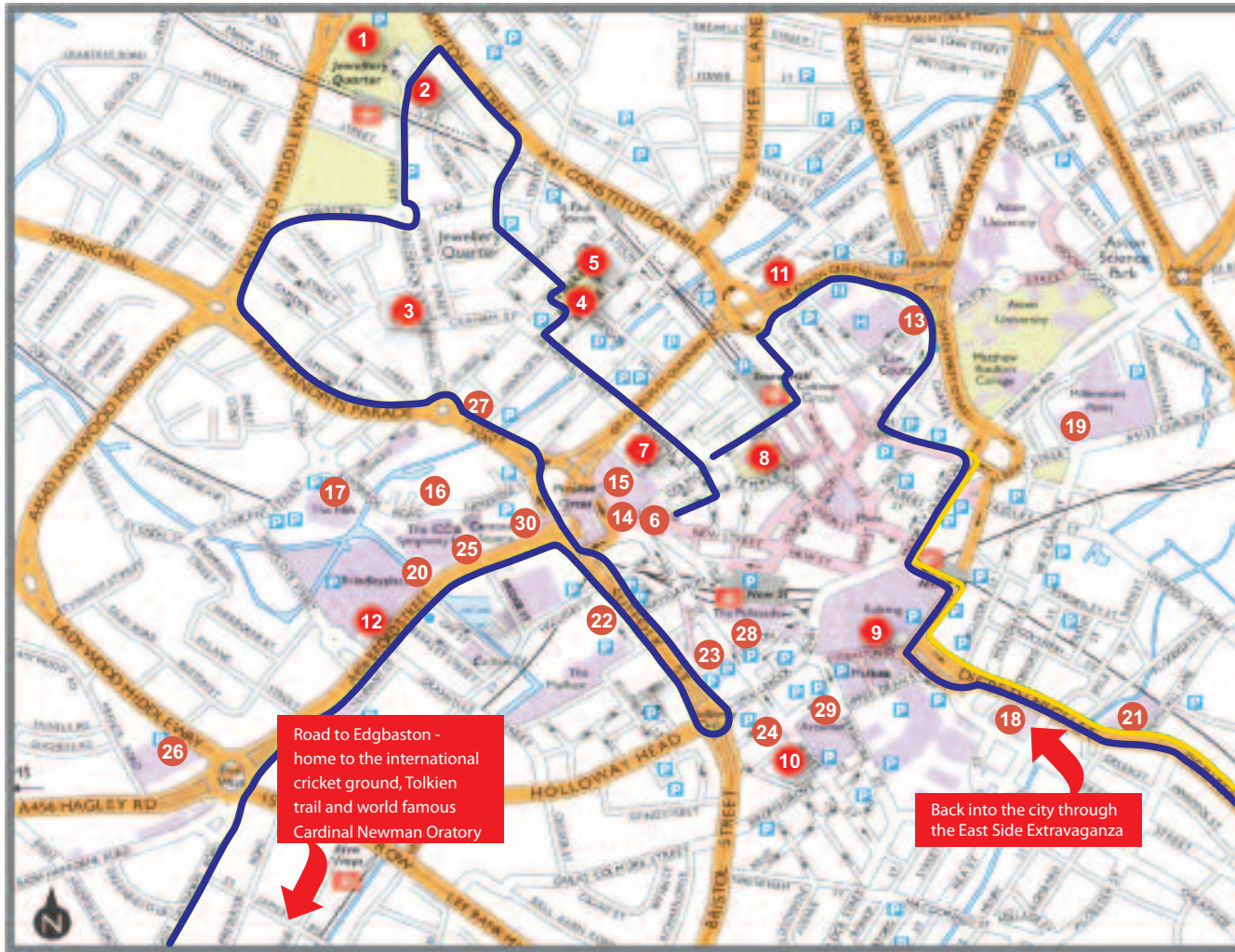
